- Advocating for what VIMI is doing to put an end to poverty in developing countries through public speaking and social media
- Inviting relevant organizations to join a coalition
- Attend 6 virtual Board meetings hosted by Zoom live video
- Drop into occasional monthly sessions via conference call or live video
